The Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS) has received a grant from the World Bank for the implementation of the **“Regional Off-Grid Electricity Access Project (ROGEAP)”** and intends to use part of this financing to recruit a Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) consultant to carry out all monitoring and evaluation activities related to the Project Component 2, particularly in the monitoring and evaluation of credit lines and direct loans deployed by the West African Development Bank (BOAD).

The consulting services (the “Services”) shall consist of the following:

- Working, with facilitation from BOAD, in close collaboration primarily with National Financial Institutions (IFNs) benefiting from ROGEAP credit lines, to assist them in developing appropriate mechanisms for data collection, compilation, analysis and reporting on project performance indicators.
- Reviewing M&E indicators and data collection tools used by IFNs and their partners; identifying available data sources and information flows.
- Collaborating closely with relevant stakeholders (IFNs, SMEs and BOAD) to collect, analyze and consolidate data, and to verify internal consistency and data validity across Component 2 actors.
- Providing on-the-ground mentoring and capacity-building support to stakeholders on M&E approaches and tools to strengthen their ability to implement M&E activities.

The shortlisting criteria are as follows:

**Qualification**

- A master's degree a Master's degree (BAC +5) in a relevant field;

**Experience and skills**

The consultant shall have at least:

- ✓ Minimum of 5 years of relevant experience in monitoring and evaluation of donor-funded programs and projects, including at least one World Bank–financed project;
- ✓ Strong quantitative and qualitative skills, with proven ability to design data collection models and analyze data;
- ✓ Solid understanding of M&E concepts, tools, methods and strategies, and demonstrated experience in program/project evaluations;
- ✓ Proficiency in GIS software (ArcGIS), statistical software (Stata, R, Python) and/or data collection tools (Open Data Kit) is an asset;
- ✓ Experience in primary data collection from households and enterprises;
- ✓ Full proficiency in English and French, with excellent written and verbal communication skills.

**Note: Nationals of ECOWAS Member States are particularly encouraged to apply.**
